

Lisa Robertson holds a master's degree in violin performance from the University of Iowa, a doctorate from Florida State University, and did additional studies in Switzerland at the Zurich Conservatory and the Institute of Higher Musical Studies in Montreux. Lisa has taught violin at Florida State University, the Peter-Cornelius-Konservatorium of Mainz (Germany), the University of Iowa, Walla Walla University, Eastern Oregon University, the Viennese Musical Institute of KwangJu (Korea), and in the Playing for Keeps program sponsored by the Oregon East Symphony in Pendleton, Oregon. Dr. Robertson was a member of professional orchestras and chamber ensembles in Europe for fifteen years. She is currently concertmaster of the Oregon East Symphony, past concertmaster of the Grande Ronde and Walla Walla symphonies, a member of the Siletz Bay Music Festival Orchestra, and serves on the board of the Oregon Chapter of the American String Teachers Association. She has been an adjudicator for MTNA for many years.
