

Dr. M. Lisa Zweben is a professional violinist and violist teacher and conductor. A native of Washington D.C., Lisa earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Violin Performance from the State University of New York, College at Purchase. She also attended the University of Miami in Coral Gables, Florida, where she earned a Master of Music in Violin Performance and Doctor of Musical Arts in Viola Performance. Principal teachers include Charles and Heidi Castleman. Lisa has been a member of many orchestras including the Royal Opera of Ghent, Belgium, the Naples Philharmonic in Naples, Florida, and the Miami City Ballet. Prior to moving to Portland in August 2010, Lisa lived in Virginia for fifteen years and was active both as a performer and teacher. In addition to maintaining a studio of private violin and viola students and performing, Lisa served as an instructor on the faculty of Virginia Tech in Women's Studies and as a violin teacher and chamber music coach at Washington and Lee University. She continues to teach and perform here in Portland and at the Castleman Quartet Program.
